



Overview


Health Resources Services Administration provides \$5,686,076 annually to Iowa for maternal, infant and early childhood home visitation programs. Contractors are required to use evidence-based home visiting models and establish quantifiable, measurable benchmarks that demonstrate:

- Improvements in maternal and child health
- Childhood injury prevention
- School readiness and achievement
- Crime or domestic violence
- Family economic self-sufficiency, and coordination with community resources and supports

Iowa Accomplishments:

- Demonstrated improvement in all six benchmark areas
- All funds awarded, obligated and expended within allowable timeframes
- Single web-based data system
- Adopted common performance measures across funding streams
- Implemented a Coordinated Intake system in partnership with the Iowa Department of Education
- Working with other states to launch the National Academy for Family Support Professionals to reduce duplication and maximize funding
- Envisioned a virtual home visitor system – Parentivity (launch scheduled for Spring 2016)
