1. ISAIC/ISU Clearinghouse

2. SBIRT Problem Gambling Pilot Update

Iowa Gambling Treatment Program Treatment-RSS Roundtable – March 11, 2016

- Below is the data discussed on the call. IDPH has provided the raw data to UNI and the Consortium to help assist tracking those individuals who screened positive and their level of engagement in services (crisis, placement screening, admission, etc.). Zion has adopted as their screen tool for SUD clients, and has about a 6% positive rate so far. Much higher than any other screening tool that has been used.





5. IGTP Monthly Counts



CFR	30 day project collecting BBGS Screenings to assess people’s risk for Gambling, with no positive screenings. Held a Drug Trends Training and included Gambling as part of the addicted brain. Ordered Gambling related educational materials from the SAMSHA website. implementing PG banners in all outpatient offices, with flyers and posters throughout the community and all program areas. Digital billboards in FD, Webster City, and Ames as well as Radio Time. CFR continues to use Money Smart at Residential and Outpatient, participating in many health fair type of events, Stacked Deck at Adolescent Residential. One Money Smart for Older Adults. In IOP, presentations on gambling every month and having clients do the gambler’s 20 questions the following week.

ISU/Help Line	ISU will be taking over the alcohol/drug Help line that was operated by ISIAC.
IDPH	SFY 2017 contract application in process. Couple of changes to allow greater flexibility. May allow 10% of budget for local HP activities; allocated dollars for treatment/rss will be a lump sum, that will be billed at the unit rates for each service. IDPH is looking at use of the I-SMART claims reconciliation engine to be used to generate claim information for IowaGrants. More information to come if this moves forward.
UNI	Gambling Attitudes and Behaviors press release today. Also, will be working on a project related to better understanding network utilization trends and identifying best practices that could help identify and engage Iowans in need of assistance for problem gambling.
