Certificates of Completion

- Five hour course completion
- One hour Initial competency skills evaluation
- Reassessment competency skills evaluation

Reassessment Dates

QRS

- Every two years

NAEYC

- Annually

QPPS

- Annually

COMPETENCY SKILLS EVALUATION

Individuals responsible for administering medication shall successfully complete the competency skills evaluation.

Participants who have completed the five hour Medication Administration in Iowa Child Care Businesses course will have a maximum of 30 days to complete the one hour initial competency skills evaluation. To renew the certificate the competency skills evaluation must be completed no later than 30 days after the expiration date on the certificate. After a period of 30 days, the participant will be required to repeat the five hour course.

The provider is responsible for scheduling their reassessment evaluation and must provide a copy of the completion certificates for the five hour course and initial skills assessment.

The skills evaluation must be performed by a Registered Nurse (RN). If the RN is not a CCNC, they must work with a CCNC or CCR&R agency in the county or region to obtain the paperwork and approval.
