

Wichealth.org Academy Online Training – February 2019

Wichealth Academy is an online training designed to help staff learn how to use, promote and integrate wichealth.org into your daily clinic workflow. This training can be found on the wichealth.org support site. <https://www.wichealth.org/support> You will need a staff account to complete the training. **To obtain a staff account with wichealth.org, you will need to email: help@wichealth.org with your first and last name, email address, state, agency and clinic.** Once your request has been approved, they will send you an invitation to create your account and then you can start the training. You can start, stop, and come back to any lesson and/or course within the training at any time, you don't have to complete an entire course or the whole academy in one session.

WIC staff shall complete all of the lessons within each course according to their staff role (as listed below) within the first three months of employment. All staff shall then login in as a client and complete three wichealth.org lessons of their choosing on an annual basis thereafter. Completion of these lessons should be recorded on your Training and Education Record (300.10a).

Some of the Academy lessons have a training guide and/or supplementary materials for downloading below the lesson, also listed in the table below. We encourage you to take a look at those materials but completing them in addition to viewing the courses is not a requirement.

After the completion of each required course, a certificate will be available to print, you are not required to print the certificate but can if you choose. You must update this form with the date each lesson was done and upon completion of all required courses, have your supervisor sign it and add it to your training record.
