<b>Topic</b>	Vaccine preventable diseases
<b>Training Technique</b>	Small group work

<b>Instructions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hand out information on 10 vaccine preventable diseases comprising the immunization requirements for attending child care</li> <li>• Give each small group one or two of the diseases to read, discuss, and report information to the large group</li> <li>• Instruct small group to write down at least 3 facts about the disease on large paper to tape on wall and share with large group</li> <li>• For Virtual Training share 3 facts about each disease as you go through the 10 diseases (slides 20-29)</li> </ul>
<b>Time</b>	15 minutes
<b>Topic</b>	Overview of 10 vaccine preventable diseases
<b>Training</b>	Lecture and large group discussion

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<b>Technique</b>	
<b>Supplies</b>	Slides 20-29
<b>Instructions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Instruct each small group leader to report on their vaccine preventable disease as the slide of that disease is shown on the power point</li> <li>• Review all diseases preventable by vaccination, including those recommended for children, teens, adults and international travelers</li> <li>• For Virtual Training share 3 facts about each disease as you go through the 10 diseases (slides 20-29)</li> </ul>
<b>Time</b>	20 minutes
<b>Topic</b>	Reliable information sources and common myths concerning vaccinations
<b>Training Technique</b>	Lecture DVD
<b>Supplies</b>	Slides 30-32
<b>Instructions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recommend reliable websites and sources for accurate vaccine information</li> <li>• Show “Vaccines: Separating Fact from Fear” (the video is divided into 10 topics. Depending on time considerations you may decide not to show all segments).</li> <li>• Videos 1-10 available at <a href="https://www.youtube.com/playlist?list=PL054F3874DB216361">https://www.youtube.com/playlist?list=PL054F3874DB216361</a></li> <li>• Discuss myths: vaccines and autism, too many vaccines too early, unsafe vaccine ingredients, and live vaccines can cause the disease</li> </ul>

<b>Topic</b>	Responding to vaccine-hesitant parents
<b>Training Technique</b>	Lecture and large group discussion
<b>Supplies</b>	Slides 33-36
<b>Instructions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Discuss appropriate responses using reliable sources of information. See AAP “Addressing Common Concerns of Vaccine-Hesitant Parents”</li> <li>• Slide 36 Poll Question #3 Discussion regarding parental concerns</li> </ul>
<b>Time</b>	10 minutes
<b>Topic</b>	How do vaccines work and are they safe?
<b>Training Technique</b>	Lecture

<b>Instructions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Live and attenuated vaccines and how vaccines produce immunity</li> </ul>
<b>Time</b>	15 minutes
<b>Topic</b>	Certificate of immunization, provisional certificates, and medical and religious exemptions and developing immunization certificate policy for your child care
<b>Training Technique</b>	Lecture and large group discussion
<b>Supplies</b>	Slides 41-51
<b>Instructions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Discuss example of incomplete immunization certificate, provisional certificate, unacceptable certificate, medical exemption and religious exemption.</li> <li>• Discuss what does not constitute a valid exemption and what the child care provider should do.</li> </ul>
