Reporting of HIV, STDs, and HCV to the Iowa Department of Public Health

Medical providers who make these diagnoses and laboratories who find positive results for the infections are **required** to report.

HIV:

Who should be reported?

- Newly diagnosed HIV-positive persons;
- Persons previously diagnosed, but new to the provider; and
- Children born to HIV-positive women.

STDs:

The following STDs are reportable in Iowa:

- Chlamydia (from any anatomic site)
- Gonorrhea (from any anatomic site)
- Syphilis

Hepatitis C Virus (HCV):

Patients with the following HCV lab results should be reported:

Screening tests:

- anti-HCV, positive or reactive

Confirmatory tests:

- HCV RNA, NAT, or PCR: positive, reactive, negative, or not detected results
- Genotyping: detected or not detected results
