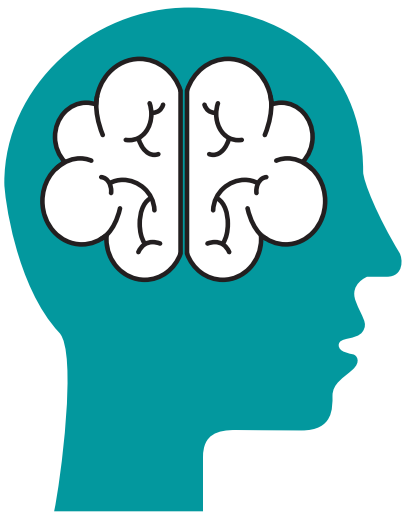


HEALTH DISPARITIES IN MALE STUDENTS

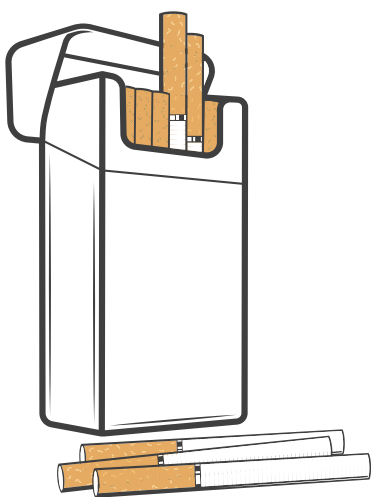


CONCUSSIONS

18% of male Iowa public high school students had a concussion from playing a sport in the past year. This compares to **10%** of females.

PHYSICAL FIGHTING

More than 1 in 5 male high school students were in a physical fight in the past year. This compares to **1 in 10** females.



SMOKING

One quarter of male high school students smoked cigarettes or cigars, vaped or used smokeless tobacco. This compares to **one-fifth** of females.

NON-SCHOOL SCREEN TIME

43% of male Iowa public high school students played video or computer games or used a computer 3 or more hours per day. This compares to **37%** of females.
