This event, *Altering Our Course: NASHIA's Virtual SOS Conference*, offers plenary and workshop sessions on a variety of topics covering the intersection of brain injury with other issues such as substance use disorders, intimate partner violence, and employment services.

- Scholarship recipient(s) must confirm their acceptance of the scholarship by Sept 6.
- Scholarship funds will be paid directly to NASHIA.
- Only individuals who reside or work in Iowa are eligible.
- Scholarship recipient(s) must agree to complete a follow up survey (a link will be sent to you after the conference) on what you learned and how you will use this information.
- Priority for support will be given to individuals who are currently working in the field of substance use disorder treatment, multicultural health, refugee services, or homeless services.
