



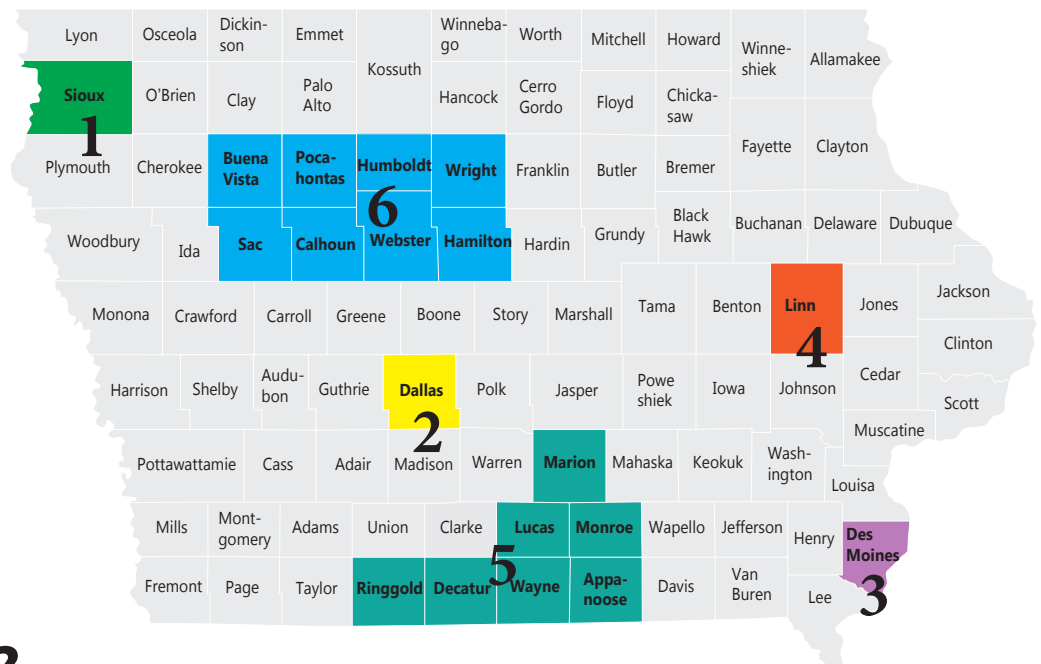

Community Care Coalitions: Who are they?

Community Care Coalitions (C3s) engage in broad-based health care system reform that will lead to better health outcomes and lower costs. C3s are locally-based coalitions of health and social service stakeholders collaborating to promote the coordination of health and community-based resources across care settings and systems of care. They consist of a broad group of community partners including health, human services, education, aging, city planners, residents, among others, and are guided by a Steering Committee.
