

# INTEGRATED TESTING SERVICES SNAPSHOT


## Prevention Services: 2019

The Bureau of HIV, STD, and Hepatitis reported record-high condom distribution for 2019, distributing **2,560,000** condoms statewide in partnership with **313 organizations**.


This represents an **increase of 122% over 2018** and an increase of 468% since 2015.

The dramatic increase in condom distribution is due to increased funding from the Ryan White Part B Supplemental award and the creation of an online ordering portal designed to engage a wider variety of condom distribution partners.

ITS PrEP Screening Data 2017 - 2019



The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) estimate that just over 4,100 Iowans could benefit from Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) to prevent acquisition of HIV.

**Available data sources estimate that approximately 1,100 Iowans had active prescriptions for PrEP medications at the end of 2018.**

Of those who tested for HIV through Integrated Testing Services in 2019, 5,787 met the CDC classification for "PrEP indicated."

- 37% of those indicated had ever heard of PrEP (compared to 36% in 2018 and 33% in 2017).
- 9% of those indicated reported PrEP use in the previous 12-month period (compared to 10% in 2018 and 8% in 2017).
- 8% of those indicated reported PrEP use as 'current' on the date of testing (compared to 8% in 2018 and 7% in 2017).
