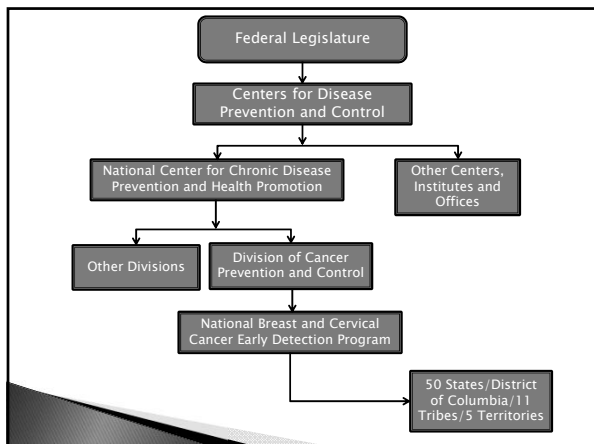


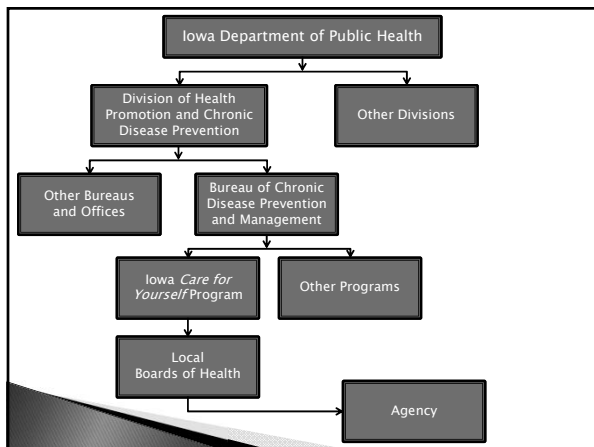

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Iowa *Care for Yourself* Program
State Staff



Women may enroll in the *Care for Yourself* Program if they:

- ▶ Are aged 40–64
- ▶ Are aged 65 or older if not enrolled in Medicare Part B
- ▶ Are Under age 40 and have a breast lump or other signs of breast cancer
- ▶ Meet set income guidelines

Iowa *Care for Yourself* Program

Care for Yourself Program staff can help a woman access:

- ▶ Office visit for:
 - Clinical breast exam
 - Pelvic exams
 - Pap tests
 - Human papillomavirus (HPV) test
- ▶ Mammograms
- ▶ Diagnostic tests
- ▶ Referrals for treatment

Services

CFY Program reimburses at Medicare Part B Participating Provider rates for Iowa

- ▶ Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) codes
- ▶ International Classification of Diseases, 9th Revision

Reimbursement





- ▶ Access to payment for treatment through Medicaid Option
- ▶ All 50 states and the District of Columbia approved this Medicaid option

Breast and Cervical Cancer Prevention and Treatment Act





Eligibility:

- ▶ Not covered by a mandatory category of Medicaid
- ▶ Under age 65
- ▶ NBCCEDP participant
- ▶ Non-creditable insurance coverage
- ▶ Precancerous/cancerous breast or cervical condition and require treatment for the cancer


Breast and Cervical Cancer Medicaid Option




- ▶ Screening and diagnostic services provided or funded by:
 - family planning centers
 - community health centers
 - non-profit organizations
- ▶ The individual must meet the eligibility requirements established by the Iowa *Care for Yourself* Program.




Eligibility (cont'd)




- ▶ Presumptive
- ▶ Ongoing
