The level of Nutrition Services and Administrative (NSA) funding for local agencies is determined by two components. The table below lists the components, their relative proportion in the NSA funds available to local agencies, and the basis for allocation.

Component	Percent	Basis for allocation
Base funding	7.5	Each county is awarded an equal share of funds.
Caseload allocation	92.5	Each agency is awarded funds based on the agency's actual participation.

**Caseload
allocation**

The caseload allocation for the next fiscal year is based on actual caseload performance of the current fiscal year.

**Contract
amendment
increases**

Additional funding is made possible to local agencies through operational adjustments and caseload reallocations. This funding is distributed to local agencies based on the agency's actual year-to-date participation for the current fiscal year. The funding will be distributed to local agencies, as the funding is made available, through the contract amendment process. Notice of funding increases will be made to local agencies no more than 10 days from the date of receipt of additional funds. If an agency's total allocation of funding based on participation does not reach the agency's ending funding total from the previous year, the State will fully fund an agency up to the agency's last years ending amount to insure continuity of WIC Program operations.

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
