RE: Data Dictionary Updates and Sotrovimab Reporting starting 10/20/2021

Thank you for your continued leadership and partnership in the COVID-19 response. IDPH received notification that HHS has assigned Therapeutic D as Sotrovimab and states are able to begin collecting on hand and administration data within the HHS Survey. This field will remain optional to report on Wednesday's only, until such time that HHS requires the data element. Hospitals will be notified 2 weeks in advance of the field becoming mandatory per HHS. Please utilize these fields for the hospital's Sotrovimab on hand and doses administered information. This reporting WILL inform the state's allocation of Sotrovimab to hospitals. It is vitally important for hospitals that are utilizing this new therapeutic to be as accurate as possible with the data to be reported on Wednesday's only starting 10/20/2021. See items 49 and 50 on pages 18 – 19 of the attached and updated data dictionary. The new therapeutic fields read as follows:

- Number of Sotrovimab courses on hand
- Sotrovimab courses administered in last calendar week

The update to the data elements listed above will be incorporated into the EMResource data collection survey starting Wednesday, October 20, 2021. IDPH retains a strong commitment to report on behalf of Iowa's hospitals, to monitor data compliance, and advocate on behalf of Iowa's hospitals.

Thank you for your continued leadership in the fight against COVID-19. Our ability to detect and respond relies on timely and accurate data from the front lines.
