- III. Discuss cost estimates and wait times for verification site visits done by out of state review teams from AAP and TJC this is required for Level IV hospitals and some Level II and Level III hospitals may want to choose this option.
  - **Pricing for the AAP NICU Verification Program**: prices listed below are over a year old.
    - Level II: \$11,5000
    - Level III: \$14,500
    - Level III with Surgical Services: \$17,500
    - Level IV: \$17,5000
    - Level IV with Surgical Services: \$20,500

    - \$6,000 annual fee per year (even if no verification visit) then additional cost for the year of depending on the Level of Care seeking verification.
