

Provisional Psychologist Documentation Required for Licensure

- Application and fee (\$120). **All application fees are nonrefundable.** To apply, print, complete and return a paper application with a check or money order payable to the Iowa Board of Psychology. You can find the application form to print on the Board's website.

- Educational Requirements:
 - Official transcripts conferring a doctoral degree in psychology from an institution accredited by the North Central Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools or an equivalent accrediting association or entity in other regions of the U.S., sent directly to the Board office from the college or university.

Note: The psychology program from which the doctoral degree was received must be one of the following:

- Accredited by the American Psychological Association, OR
- Accredited by the Canadian Psychological Association, OR
- Designated by the Association of State and Provincial Psychology Boards (ASPPB)/ National Register Designation Project as a doctoral program in psychology, OR
- The applicant must hold a specialty diploma by examination from the American Board of Professional Psychology.

Please note: Foreign-trained applicants should contact the Board office for educational requirements.

- Supervision Plan Requirements:
 - A completed Supervision Registration Form must be submitted to the Board office before approval to take the EPPP exam will be granted. The Supervision Registration Form can be found on the Board's website.
