## Priority 1

Affordability/Accessibility

### Data/Rationale

2013 Significant need, 2016 significant health need, 2016 Local Expert Concern 13% of survey respondents identified this as a priority need.

## Priority 2

Mental Health

### Data/Rationale

Local expert concern; Boone County's Population to Mental Health Provider Ratio is worse than the state and national averages; Suicide is the #9 Leading Cause of Death in Boone County; Boone County's Mental and Substance Use Related Deaths increased from 1980-2014.

Is this issue addressed in an improvement plan? Yes

## Priority 3

Obesity

### Data/Rationale

2016 Significant Need; Boone County's Adult Obesity rate is worse than the state and national averages; Residents of Boone County are 17% more likely to have a BMI of Morbid/Obese compared to the national average; Diabetes is the #7 Leading Cause of Death in Boone County; Boone County's Diabetes, Urogenital, Blood and Endocrine Disease Deaths are worse than the national average and saw an increase from 1980-2014.

Is this issue addressed in an improvement plan? No

### Reasons why this issue is not addressed in an improvement plan:

Due to relatively low priority assigned to Obesity, BCH chose not to respond to this need at this time. BCH feels they will have greater impact by putting attention and resources towards other significant needs for which BCH is better qualified to serve.

Drug/Substance Abuse

### Data/Rationale

Local expert concern; Boone County's Mental and Substance Use Related Deaths increased from 1980-2014.

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## Priority 5

Heart Disease

### Data/Rationale

Local expert concern; Heart Disease is the #1 Leading Cause of Death in Boone County and the Heart Disease Death rate is worse than the state and national averages; Hypertension/Renal is the #13 Leading Cause of Death in Boone County.
